Scholarship Award:

- One Scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1000

Eligibility for High School student submissions:

- In process to complete the twelfth (12th) grade level in public, private or home-schooled education
- Have a parent or legal guardian who receive trash and recycling services with the Village of The Hills
- Plans to attend a university, college, junior college, technical, or trade school to obtain an undergraduate level degree or trade certification.
- Must submit an application and required document(s) by the posted deadline

Judging Process:

Applications and essays are evaluated based on a fair unbiased judging process. Judges are selected by Village of The Hills. To ensure anonymity of participants and a transparent scoring process, judges will not see personal information from the application or essay. Applicants' names are unknown to judges until after the results are finalized.

Awards:

All applicants will be notified of award status by email and funds distributed to winner with intended use for tuition or similar. Scholarship funds must be used within one year of the award date. Village of The Hills has the right to extend the timeline of use when deemed appropriate.
