

RESOLUTION 66-11

**RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF THE HILLS, TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS,
REPEALING RESOLUTION NUMBER 65-11, WHICH MAKES CHANGES TO
THE VILLAGE'S GENERAL ELECTION PURSUANT TO THE MOVE ACT,
EIGHTY-SECOND REGULAR LEGISLATURE: SENATE BILL 100:**

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature implemented the MOVE Act in 2011 with the passage of Senate Bill 100, which overlaid the period between the states primary and primary runoff election upon the most commonly-used uniform election date for the municipal general election which is the second Saturday in May; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the Village of The Hills did change the General Election date to the second Tuesday in November pursuant to Section 41.0052 in SB 100; and

WHEREAS, Travis County has kept the uniform election date for the municipal general election which is the second Saturday in May, and


WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the Village of The Hills believes it is to the advantage of the Village, its citizens and the pursuit of democracy to hold the municipal general election on the uniform election date which is the second Saturday in May.

**NOW, THEREFORE; RESOLUTION NUMBER 65-11 IS REPEALED AND
HEREAFTER THE VILLAGE OF THE HILLS WILL HOLD ITS MUNICIPAL
GENERAL ELECTION ON THE SECOND SATURDAY IN MAY.**
