

RESOLUTION NO. 76-13

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 5, 2013 LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX ELECTION.

WHEREAS, The Village of The Hills (the Village") called an election to be held November 5, 2013 for the purpose of voting on a proposition to renew the Sales Tax within the Village;

WHEREAS, the Village contracted with the Travis County Elections Division to hold and report the result of the election in compliance with the Texas Election Code and Chapter 321, Texas Tax Code;

WHEREAS, the local option sales tax election was held on November 5, 2013 (the "Election"), to allow voters the choice of renewing a municipal sales tax of $\frac{1}{4}$ of one percent for the purpose of maintenance and repair of municipal streets (Proposition 1);

WHEREAS, Travis County held the Election for and on behalf of the Village, in full compliance with state law, and delivered the "Village of The Hills Canvass Report" attached hereto as Exhibit "A", providing a true and correct canvass of the vote on Proposition No. 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF THE HILLS, THAT:

Section 1. The Village of The Hills Canvass Report attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Exhibit "A" is hereby approved and found to be true and correct in all respects.

Section 2. The canvass of the votes cast in the Election on the submitted proposition are as follows:

Proposition 1. The adoption of a local sales and use tax in the Village of The Hills at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets.

For – 319 votes

Against – 126 votes

Proposition Number 1 was approved by a margin of 193 votes.
