

ORDINANCE NO. 60-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF THE HILLS ADOPTING THE FIRE CODE OF TRAVIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISCTRRICT #6, REGULATING AND GOVERNING THE SAFEGUARDING OF LIFE AND PROPERTY FROM FIRE AND EXPLOSION HAZARDS ARISING FROM THE STORAGE, HANDLING AND USE OF HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES, MATERIALS AND DEVICES, AND FROM CONDITIONS HAZARDOUS TO LIFE OR PROPERTY IN THE OCCUPANCY OF BUILDINGS AND PREMISES IN THE VILLAGE OF THE HILLS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFOR.

THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF THE HILLS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the Municipal Clerk of the Village of The Hills, being marked and designated as the Fire Code of the Travis County Emergency Services District #6, be and is hereby adopted as the Fire Code of the Village of The Hills, in the State of Texas regulating and governing the safeguarding of life and property from fire and explosion hazards arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices, and from conditions hazardous to life or property in the occupancy of buildings and premises as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefor; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Fire Code on file in the office of the Village of The Hills are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance.

Section 2. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Aldermen hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

Section 3. That the Municipal Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to cause this ordinance to be published.

Section 4. That this ordinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its final passage and adoption.
